Schedule for Changes to Maximum Prices Canada Day 2015

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board wishes to advise petroleum wholesalers about upcoming changes to the dates when maximum petroleum prices will be issued by the Board. The *Petroleum Products Pricing Act* (PPPA) and *New Brunswick Regulation 2006-41* mandate that changes to maximum prices come into effect each Thursday, with wholesalers receiving notice of the changes the day prior. Under certain circumstances, the legislation prescribes changes to the schedule, circumstances which will occur next week.

As Canada Day (July 1, 2015) falls on a Wednesday this year, section 3(2) of New Brunswick Regulation 2006-41 applies:

where Wednesday is a statutory holiday, the Board shall set the maximum wholesale and retail prices to take effect the following Friday.

As per the Regulation, new maximum prices for the Canada Day pricing period will be sent to wholesalers on Thursday July 2, 2015. New prices will come into effect on Friday July 3, 2015.

As always, in accordance with section 3(4) of the PPPA, wholesalers are to ensure that retailers to whom they sell petroleum products are informed of any changes to maximum prices before they come into effect.
